DAILY KINDERGARTEN ROUTINES

Morning Circle

Here we will gather together in our outdoor classroom for the following:

- *Welcome Song
- *Weekly Theme Song
- *Morning Message
- *The Mystery Box (This holds a story from our classroom fairy)
- *Read Aloud

Language Lesson

Students will work on a language lesson tailored to their level and based on the theme we are exploring that week.

Word Work

Students will listen to our weekly letter sound song, word family song and word family story. They will complete an activity tailored to their learning level.

Physical Education

Students will participate in a series of fine and gross motor activities, learning games, sports and movement activities.

Read Aloud & Sharing Time

Students will listen to a story based on the theme of the week and have the opportunity to step into the role of an author and illustrator and share their work with others.

STEM

Students will explore an activity based on our daily theme that incorporates mathematics, science and art.

Yoga & Mindfulness

*Students participate in a daily yoga class to reset and recharge them for the afternoon.

Math Routine

This includes:

- *The Date
- *Daily Survey
- *Number of Days in School
- *Jumping the Time
- *General Store for the Helper of the Day
- *Patterning & Shape game
- *Counting Songs

Math Centres

Students will create structures with individual bins of math manipulatives and building materials. Students will explore themes of measurement, structures and stability, shapes, patterns and other weekly math themes.

Outdoor Inquiry

We will help students explore nature and come up with weekly "I Wonder" questions that will help us shape our inquiry for the week.

Mystery Object

*The helper of the day brings a mystery object. Students will apply their deductive reasoning skills as they attempt to infer what the mystery object is.
